Award Categories & Prizes:

- 2012 Overall Vision Award Winner – Venice Architecture Biennale prize
- Commercial Energy Efficient Glass Design - \$1,000 prize money
- Residential Energy Efficient Glass Design - \$1,000 prize money
- Commercial Creative Interior Glass Application - \$1,000 prize money
- Residential Creative Interior Glass Application - \$1,000 prize money

*Please note for the purposes of these awards, multi-residential designs are classified under the commercial category.

Independent financial advice should be sought as tax implications may arise as a result of accepting any prize.

First Prize (Overall Winner)

- Prize includes 2 x Vernissage Passes for the 2012 Venice Architecture Biennale
- The Vernissage is an exclusive three day opening of the Venice Architecture Biennale, that precedes the public opening. During this time, the Biennale can only be accessed by exclusive Vernissage Pass holders which cannot be purchased and are only allocated to media and the organizers of participating countries.
- The dates for the 2012 Venice Architecture Biennale have not yet been announced and are expected to be known later in 2011. It is likely that the event will fall in September, October and November 2012. Once dates are announced they will be published on our website <http://www.viridianglass.com/visionawards/default.aspx>
- The prize includes flights and accommodation for two people. These will be finalized once the dates for the Biennale are announced.

Prize Conditions

- The winner and travelling companion must travel at the time specified by CSR Building Products Limited t/as Viridian (which will coincide with the dates of the Biennale), must depart from the same capital city and are responsible for transport from their residence to their nearest capital city for flight departure.
- The winner and their companion will be responsible for all other expenses including spending money, meals, drinks, transfers (unless specified), incidentals, taxes (excluding departure and any other flight associated taxes included within the prize), gratuities, travel insurance and all other ancillary costs.
- By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to participate in and co-operate as required with all reasonable media editorial requests relating to the prize, including but not limited to, being interviewed and photographed during the duration of the First Prize.

Choice of winners:

Winners of each of the Awards will be chosen at the sole and absolute discretion of the jury appointed by Viridian, with regard to the Selection Criteria referred to below.

Eligibility:

- Any Australian based design professional may enter a completed Australian based project
- Projects must have been completed in between January 1st and December 31st 2011
- Projects must be complete
- Project must contain Viridian products
- Multiple entries are permitted, however are limited to one entry per category
- The applicant must be the architectural practice responsible for the project

Key Dates:

- Entries will be accepted until April 30th 2012. Any project submitted after this date will not be considered.
- The dates for the 2012 Venice Architecture Biennale are expected to be released later in 2011. It is likely that the event will fall in September, October and November 2012. Once dates are announced they will be published on our website <http://www.viridianglass.com/visionawards/default.aspx>
- Awards will be presented during the AIA National Architecture Conference, held in Brisbane on May 10-12, 2012.

Publicity & Copyright:

- You must obtain your client's written approval to enter the competition as well as obtain their approval to be mentioned in any resultant publicity. In the case of residential projects, the client's name and address will not be published, however photos of their property may be published.
- You must obtain written permission from photographer (including any necessary copyright and moral rights consents/waivers) for Viridian to use images in promotional material, including case studies that Viridian may want to promote via web, email and print.
- By entering, you are confirming that you are the principal or that you have obtained authority from your principal to enter the program, including any resultant publicity.

The organiser reserves the right to exhibit or publish any or all of the entries. By entering the awards you are confirming that you have obtained all the relevant copyright approvals which give permission to the organiser to publish, exhibit and promote the content of the submission. - Submissions must include a project floor plan.
- At least 5 digital images of the project, showcasing the use of glass in the project, must be attached. Images to be in JPG format.
- Submissions can only be made online. No hard copies will be accepted.

Selection Criteria:

The selection criteria used by the jury shall include, but are not limited to the following:

- Degree of complexity of the glazing

- Energy efficiency levels of the glazing
- Creative use of glass in interior applications
- Overall demonstration of applying glass in extraordinary ways
